

RMB Dress Code

Class A Attire

Parades:

Black Shirt. Black Pants. Black Socks. Black Shoes. Marching Band Jackets will be provided.

- Pants must be presentable, unfaded, and without holes.
- All clothing items must allow freedom of movement, as students will be marching.
- Shoes must be solid black. No white trim, logos, or visible outer soles.
- All students with hair longer than their shirt collar must have their hair tied back in a low ponytail or bun. Hair of any length must be, at all times, out of the face as not to disrupt musical play.

For Lights On Celebrations ONLY: Students are encouraged to wear portable holiday lights on their instrument and clothing, however lighting must not interfere with safety, movement, and/or musical play.

Concert Attire

Formal Concerts:

Boys: Black Dress Shirt. Black Tie. Black Pants. Black Socks. Black Shoes.

Girls: Black Skirt, Black Dress, or Black Pants. Black Dress Shirt, if applicable. Black Dress Tights for Skirts & Dresses, or Black Socks if Pants are worn. Black Shoes.

- Pants must be presentable, unfaded, and without holes.
- Shoes must be solid black. No white trim, white logos, or visible white outer soles.
- Skirts and dresses must be appropriate; When holding arms straight down to the side, skirts and dresses must measure at least to the tips of the student's fingers.
- All students with hair longer than their shirt collar must have their hair tied back in a low ponytail or bun. Hair of any length must be, at all times, out of the face as not to disrupt musical play.

Class B Attire

Showcases / Competitions / Football Games:

RMB Polo. Black Pants. Black Socks. Black Shoes.

- Pants must be presentable, unfaded, and without holes.
- All clothing items must allow freedom of movement, as students will be traveling.
- Shoes must be solid black. No white trim, white logos, or visible white outer soles.
- All students with hair longer than their shirt collar must have their hair tied back in a low ponytail or bun. Hair of any length must be, at all times, out of the face as not to disrupt musical play.
- Polos must be tucked.

Should a student arrive at any event wearing incorrect or inappropriate attire, they may be subject to dismissal and potentially forfeit academic credit. If, at ANY time, there is a financial barrier encountered just let the Music Director, Mr. Martinez, or any member of the Rancho Maze Band Booster Board, know in advance and we will take care of it discreetly.
